

Emeritus Faculty Policy

Concordia University shall recognize as Emeritus Faculty individuals who

- have retired from Concordia University Wisconsin,
- as full time faculty,
- in good standing,
- have served in such positions for a minimum of 5 years,
- have been nominated by the President,
- and have been approved by the University's Board of Regents.

Benefits to Emeritus Faculty members and their spouses may include

- free admission to all campus extracurricular events (e.g. athletic games, musical performances, dramatic presentations, etc.),
- privileges to use the Rincker Library collections and facilities,
- receipt of CUW publications,
- participation in University Opening and Commencement activities,
- invitation to an annual Presidential Dinner held to honor such faculty and faculty spouses,
- and eligibility to serve on special University boards, councils, and committees, at the invitation of the President.
