The purpose of this document is to form an Articulation Agreement between Concordia University Wisconsin (CUW) and Concordia University in Portland, Oregon (CUP) regarding the EdD programs. The Articulation Agreement would serve the interests of students currently enrolled in the five EdD programs at CUP—Education Administrative Leadership; Professional Leadership, Inquiry, and Transformation; Organizational and Transformational Leadership, Instructional Leadership in Teaching, and Higher Education Leadership Online—who are seeking to transfer and enroll in CUW's Doctorate of Education in Leadership in Innovation and Continuous Improvement (LICI) program.

Due to CUP's closure, which is scheduled for the end of April, 2020, CUW is willing to enter into an agreement with CUP students, beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 through December 31, 2021, for those who want to enroll in the CUW LICI program with the following understanding and conditions:

- Students must meet the application requirements of CUW (an expedited application process will be deployed specially for CUP students).
- Students must complete the sixty credit requirement of the LICI program.
- CUW will waive both four-day residency requirements if students have accumulated over 36 credits in their current EdD program. If students have less than 36 credits, they will be required to participate in a minimum of one residency.
- Students who are close to program completion (45 credits or more) and have had their dissertation proposal accepted will be allowed to retain their current Dissertation Chair/Advisor if they so choose.
- Students will be required to take a short Blackboard and online training module as established by CUW's Office of Distance and Continuing Education (OCDE) department.
- All credits earned in the CUP EdD programs will be eligible for transfer and application to the LICI requirements. Only courses with B grades or better will be accepted.

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 CUP Phase I Core Classes will be applied to the Leadership Core and the Innovation and Improvement Science Core of the LICI program:

- CUP Phase I and II Scholarly Writing Courses will be applied to the Introduction to Doctoral Program and Research Methods Course (EDG 9000) in the LICI Program (3 credits).
- CUP Concentration courses (unique to the five EdD programs) will be applied to the LICI Elective concentration (12 credits) as well as to the Leadership Core courses (EDG 9010 Exemplary Leadership Case Studies, EDG 9020 Innovative and Entrepreneurial Leadership) and Innovation and Improvement Science Core courses (EDG 9200 Six Sigma Applications, EDG 9210 Lean Systems Analysis) as appropriate and determined by the Program Director review.
- Students who have not taken improvement science courses or have a gap in improvement science learning will be required to take the EDG XXXX LICI Seminar Topics course (3 credits), which will use the interdisciplinary approach of the program to focus on improvement science and emphasize the continuous improvement aspect of the LICI program.
