How do I get started?

Every Falcon has an account with Handshake. Follow these steps to access:

- First time log-in: Once you have <u>registered</u> for classes go to <u>cuw.joinhandshake.com/login</u>, click on and login with your CUW single sign on credentials (<u>F00 number only</u>, not email address). Follow the steps to your landing page and create your profile.
- If you already have an account follow the same steps and update your profile!
- Once you are logged in create your <u>profile</u>. The more you include in your profile and interests the better Handshake can populate opportunities you care about.
