CUW was founded in 1881.



Location and Campus: CUW is located on the shores of Lake Michigan, 15 miles north of downtown [Milwaukee](#) in suburban [Mequon, Wisconsin](#). The university has 9 [additional classroom locations](#) including the city of Milwaukee (2), Kenosha, Waukesha, Appleton, Green Bay, Beloit, Madison and Saint Louis. 1385 students attend classes at these locations (17%) with an additional 1956 students in E-Learning (25%). 3775 students (49%) are located at the main/Mequon campus and 605 students (8%) at additional classroom locations.

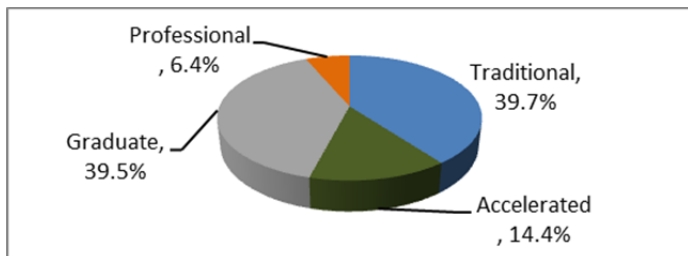
