Standard for Retention

- Student retention should be at a threshold of 70% of total enrollment.

Standard for credentialing success

For multiple concentration programs

- 60% overall take and pass rate and earn a credential within one year of graduation.
- At some point during the five or ten year accreditation cycle the program must demonstrate that some graduates have been successful obtaining in all of the credentials the curriculum is designed to teach.

Standards for number of graduates employed in a relevant setting

- At least 75% of graduates must be employed as sonographers, continuing their education, or in the military in one of the program's accredited specialties within six months of graduation.
