What degree should I earn?

The PhD has a more intensive research focus and an elite level of scholarship. The PhD is for people who want to be experts and trend-setters. What is unique about the LICI program?

As a doctoral student at Concordia, you will be fully supported by a caring team of faculty and staff who are with you every step of the way.
