

Cooperating Teacher Requirements

PI 34.023 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code specifies that cooperating teachers must meet all of the following requirements:

- a) Holds a valid Wisconsin license, or an equivalent license if the clinical program is located outside of Wisconsin.
- b) Volunteered for an assignment as a cooperating teacher or school-based supervisor.
- c) Has at least three years of teaching experience, including one year of at the current place of employment.
- d) Has completed training in the supervision of clinical students and the applicable

standards.* * CUW will provide a video course to satisfy this requirement.

<u>Concordia University Wisconsin (CUW) requires a current Compliance Statement to verify</u> <u>items a, c, and d of each Cooperating Teacher. Proof of completion of the CUW supervision</u> <u>course is done by Cooperating Teachers via an online questionnaire.</u>
