

Pre-Pharmacy – Concordia University Wisconsin

The pre-pharmacy requirements can be completed in two years and must be completed before starting the PharmD program. Many applicants are completing the pre-pharmacy requirements during the application process. All pre-pharmacy requirements must be completed with a grade of C- or better. Advanced Placement (AP) courses taken in high school may be used to fulfill pre-pharmacy requirements.
