

Ideas for Types of Service Learning Courses

In planning and creating a service learning model that will work for your specific course, it is important to note that all service learning does not have to look the same. One of the models described below may be a better match for your particular course than another, but all are important and relevant forms of service learning.

The Placement Model: students work a few hours each week at a particular site

The Presentation Model: students take course material and make presentations in the community

The Presentation-Plus Model: All students in the class work with the same organization and put on a fair or mini-conference

The Product Model: Students work alone or in groups to produce a product for a particular agency

The Project Model: Student groups work with community partners to devise and implement a service project
