Pre-College Programs

Concordia Promise Dual Credit

- Eligible students attend a Christian high school or are home schooled
- \$78 per credit

Michigan's Postsecondary Education Options Act (PEOA)

- Eligible students attend a public or private high school in Michigan
- · Cost is paid by the state or school district
- \$155 per credit

Wisconsin Early College Credit (ECCP)

- Eligible students attend a public or private high school in Wisconsin
- Cost is shared by the state, school district, and in some cases the student
- \$155 per credit

Dual Credit

- Eligible students attend a public high school outside Wisconsin or Michigan
- \$155 per credit

Admission requirements

- Students eligible in grade 9-12
- Cumulative 3.0 GPA in high school academic classes
- For PEOA funding, a qualifying PSAT, ACT or SAT score is required

To apply:

- Visit CUW.EDU/APPLY or CUAA.EDU/APPLY (Michigan residents) and select the Dual Enrollment option
- Submit your high school transcript and an ECCP form (if applicable)
